Harvesting Small Forest Blocks

This workshop is designed to help you, as a forest owner, get a better understanding of harvesting your forestry block; including managing environmental impacts and selecting contractors.

This includes forest owners who are not forestry professionals, those who own a forest that isn't managed by a forestry company or those who have responsibility for harvesting plantation forestry but don't know where to start.
